TO: Participating Districts, Clubs and Teams
RE: Coastal Cup Schedule

March 19, 2020

With the current health situation in BC, and taking the lead from BC Soccer and the Provincial Health Office, the Coastal Cup committee must notify participants of the postponement of Coastal Cup play until the month of May, 2020.

Please note BC Soccer's news release [here](#) stating soccer activity should not occur in April.

How does this impact the current scheduled games?

All currently scheduled rounds of play will be moving to May dates, see new schedule below.

Does this impact who qualifies for the Provincial Cup?

No, with this delay in starting the Coastal Cup, the plan is to still play all rounds which will determine the qualifiers for the Provincial Cup in July.

What if the COVID-19 health crisis doesn't get better?

We realize these are trying times, and this decision is based on our best estimates at the present time for a return to play in May. We are in regular dialogue with BC Soccer, and will always take direction from the Provincial Health Office, and will re-evaluate Coastal Cup play as and when required.

What if I can't field a team in May?

If we do return to play in May, teams will be expected to fulfill a scheduled game. If they can't for whatever reason, the Coastal Cup committee will engage the club and district involved as to whether a replacement team will be found or a bye inserted in that team's spot in the draw.

May 1-3 – Round of 16

May 8-10 – Quarterfinals

May 22-24 – Semifinals

May 30/31 - Finals
